

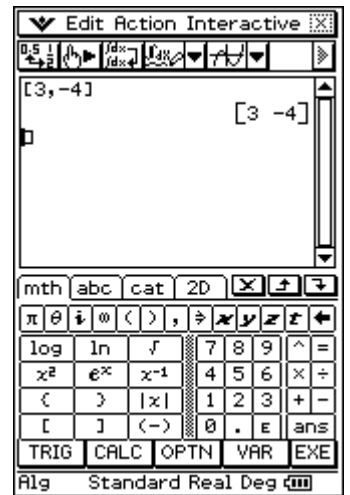

Although templates exist for vectors in the 2D, CALC menu, it is often simpler to use the form  $[a, b]$  when entering a vector  $ai + bj$ .

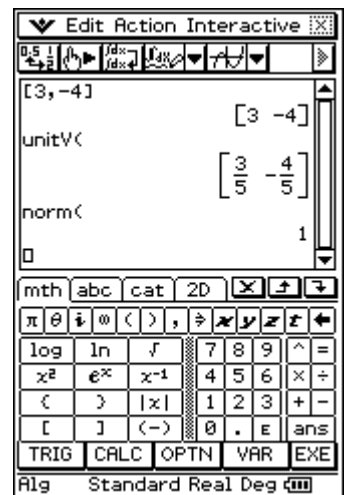
Start in Main.

Enter  $[3, -4]$  using the square brackets from the mth menu and tap **EXE**.

*Note ClassPad removes the comma.*



All vector operations accept vectors entered this way.



Using vectors in this way uses up much less screen space and makes it easier to follow your calculations.
