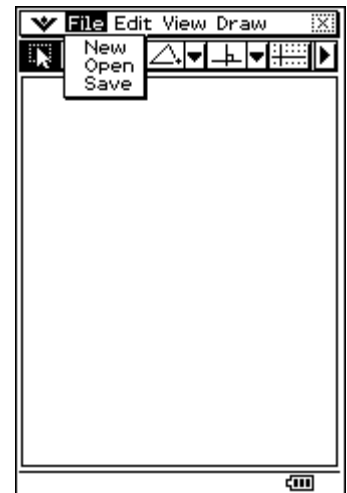
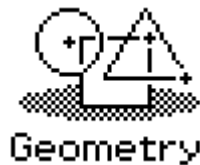


Tap

Start a new geometry file, tap **File, New** and then **OK**.

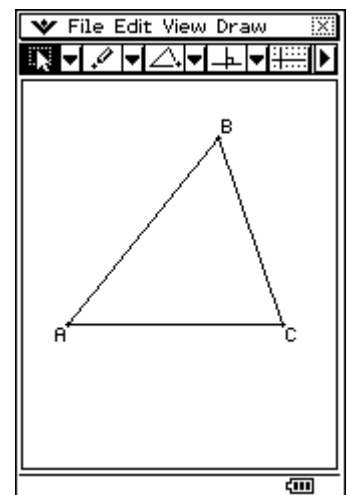
Draw a triangle:

Tap the triangle icon



Either tap anywhere on the screen

or, tap the screen and drag the stylus to form a box.

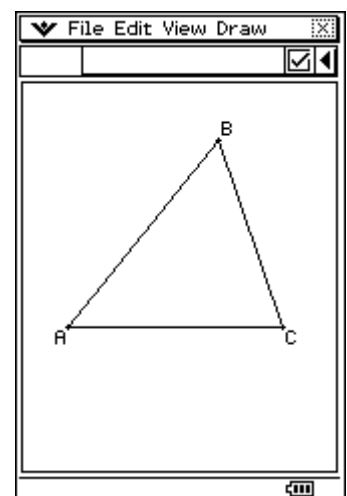


Tap the right arrow



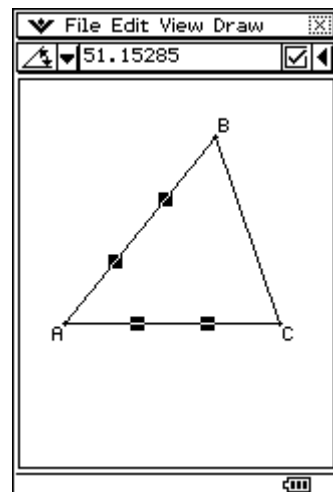
at the far right of the toolbars to

display the information box of the measurement toolbar.



Create a right triangle:

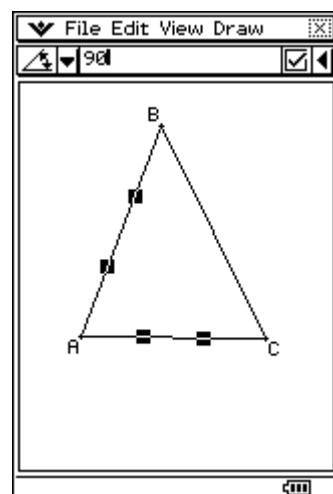
Tap on two sides of the triangle to show the size of the angle formed by these two sides.



Tap on the angle size in the box and type 90, tap on the tick.

This constrains the angle to always be 90°.


To clear a constraint, tap on a shaded tick box or use Edit, Clear Constraints to clear all constraints.




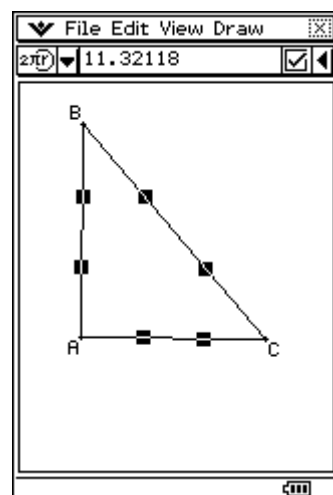
To determine or constrain other features of the triangle:

Length of a side: tap on a side

Size of an angle: tap on the two sides forming the angle

Area of the triangle: tap on all three sides of the triangle, tap on the first down arrow, tap on 

Perimeter of the triangle: tap on all three sides of the triangle, tap on the first down arrow, tap on 



NOTE: To deselect all, tap on a blank part of the screen.
