


Create a new geometry file tap **File, New** and then **OK** if prompted.

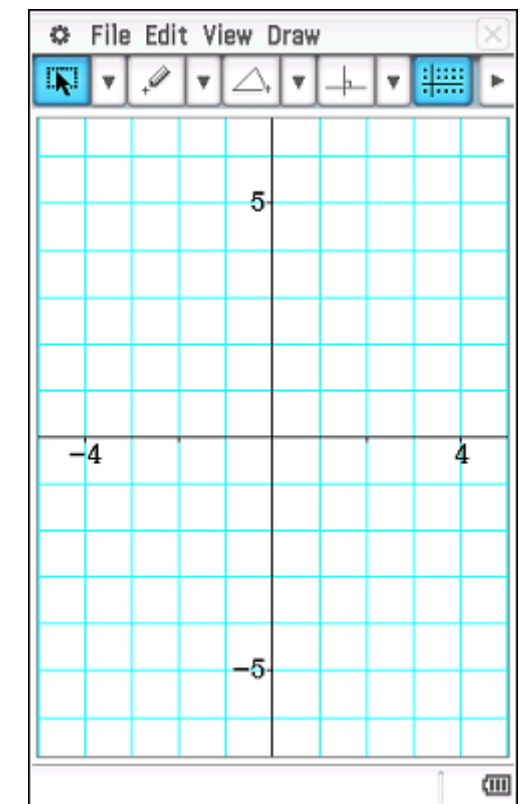
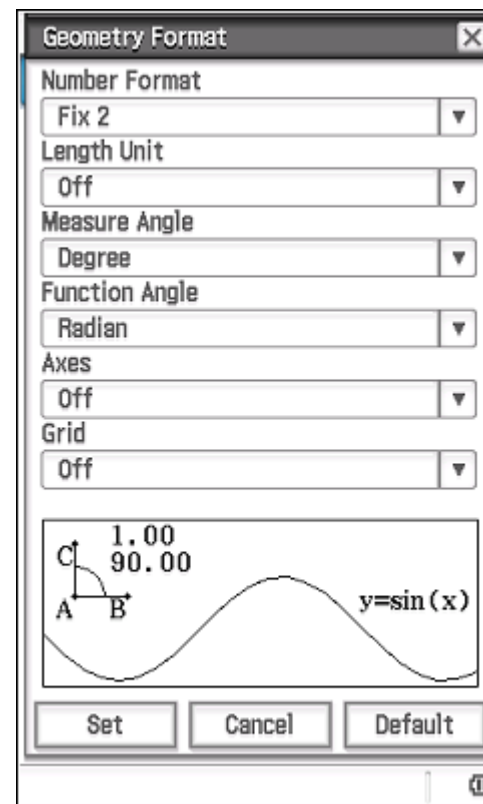
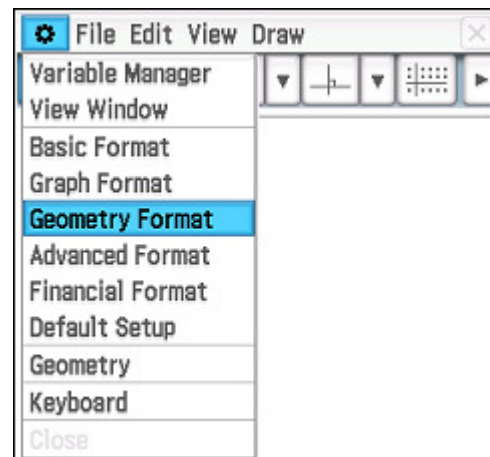
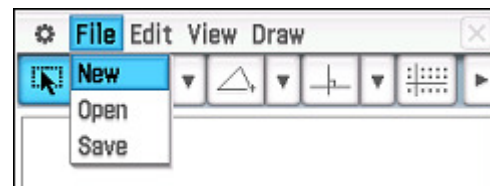
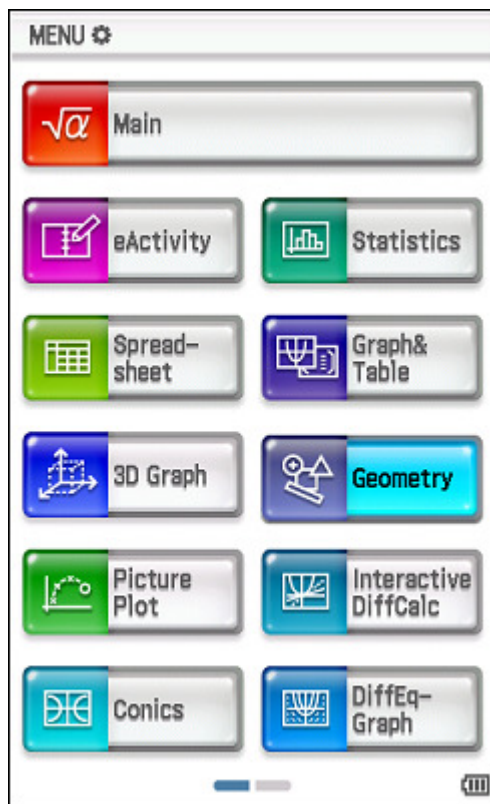
Start the Geometry app.


Tap Settings (⚙️), **Geometry Format**.

Tap **Default** and then **Set**.

Tap several times on  until the required combination of axes, scale and integer grid are displayed.

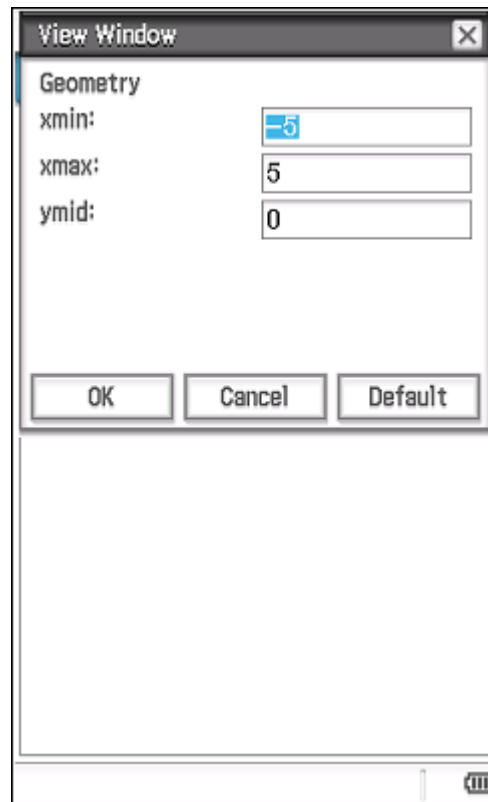
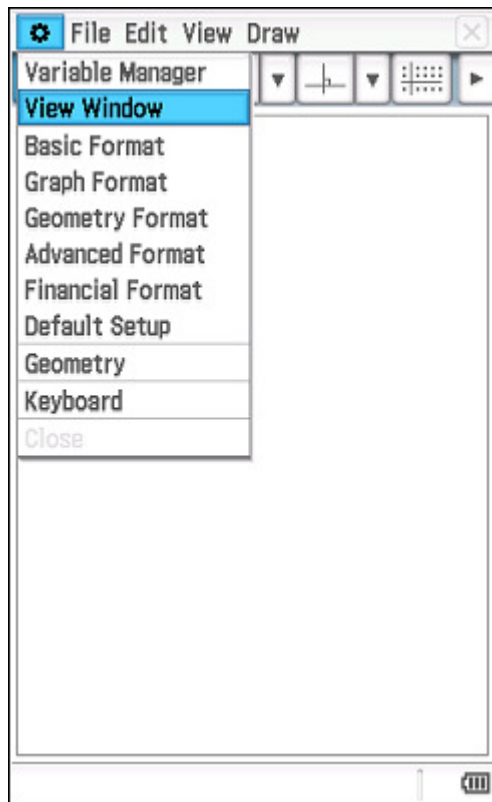
If coordinate work is involved, it is useful to have the grid displayed. Classpad will 'lock' points to the nearest integer grid point.



To set the View Window in Geometry, tap  and then tap **View Window**.

Enter the required values and tap **OK**.

Classpad maintains the same scale on both x and y-axes and so it is not possible to set the y-min and max, just the y value for the middle of the screen



Saving Geometry files

Any Geometry file can be saved for later recall.

Tap **File, Save**.

Type in a name for the file and tap **Save**.

Geometry file names are limited to eight characters, must start with a letter and contain no spaces.
